



- PMTSF (2014 to 2019)- Priority 8,3 -"Stimulating rural development, land reform and food security"
















Snapshot of Spatial and Economic status - Poverty Zones and Poorest Wards























The Development Framework – Land Capability Index and Crop Potential







Land Capability Index and Commodity Potential







Forestry	 Opportunities for large-scale forestry development throughout the Elundini LM, as the region has extremely high potential for large developments, with respect to the rest of the province. Community owned forestry plantation enterprises
Agricultural production expansion	 Develop commercial maize farming initiatives Ostrich production initiatives near Venterstad Develop game parks and tourist offerings in the Gariep Municipality, west of Burgersdorp
Cooperative and Small-Scale	 Process local wool and mohair production for local and tourism markets. Develop commercial, small-scale and cooperative cattle production initiatives across the Joe Gqabi DM, excluding the northern half of the Gariep LM






