

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


PROPOSED ROLL OUT STRATEGY FOR **RURAL DEVELOPMENT PLANS IN SOUTH AFRICA**




Rural Development Plan, 1995

- SIP14 Agri- logistics and rural infrastructure

Provincial Government

- PMTSF (2014 to 2019)- Priority 8,3 -"Stimulating rural development, land reform and food security"






Snapshot of Spatial and Economic Status Spatial and Settlement Pattern










The Development Framework – Climate and Rainfall








The Development Framework -Land Capability Index and Crop Potential








The Development Framework -Land Capability Index and Livestock Potential








The Development Framework Land Capability Index and Commodity Potential






The Sarah Baartman DM Rural Development Plan




